Senior Reservoir Engineer - France

Reporting to the Asset Team Leader, France, the Senior Reservoir Engineer will be responsible for evaluating and managing the recovery potential of Vermilion's French oil and gas properties. The successful candidate will have a BSc or MSc in Petroleum Engineering (or other relevant discipline) with 10-15 years international experience in conventional petroleum exploitation and development and in the coordination and management of reserves evaluations and production forecasts. Experience in exploration and unconventional play types, as well as fluency in French, would be assets. Primary responsibilities for this role include:

- Assessment, monitoring and optimization of oil and gas recovery for Vermilion's assets in the Aquitaine Basin;
- Identifying opportunities for Exploitation including studies, simulation, lab work, formation evaluation and testing, drilling, completion, workovers, waterflood and pool management;
- Working with the team to develop and manage a "Drilling Portfolio Inventory" system for ranking prospects;
- Total field optimization including well placement, number of wells, spacing, injection requirements, rate and reserve forecasts;
- Evaluation work with Exploitation Engineers to support drilling opportunities including productivity, reserves, costs, risk assessment, economics, approvals, project management and execution;
- Coordination of well placement with Geological and Geophysical team as it relates to spacing requirements, surface considerations, drilling limitations and pool management;
- Providing recommendations on the completion and workover of new and existing wells, and liaising with the Asset team to recommend programs;
- Maintaining and ensuring the accuracy and integrity of the corporate reserves within the assigned areas of responsibility; and
- Providing support to Business Development for oil and gas asset evaluation of acquisition and divestiture opportunities.
